Resolve in favor of William M. Heftye of Lynn.

1 *Resolved*, That after an appropriation has been
2 made there be allowed and paid out of the treasury
3 of the commonwealth to William M. Heftye of
4 Lynn, who was injured while in the service of
5 the commonwealth as a member of the state
6 guard, the sum of thirty-five hundred dollars.
7 Payment under authority of this resolve shall be
8 made only upon the filing of satisfactory re-
9 leases or other evidence that the payment is
10 accepted in full compensation on the part of the
11 commonwealth in respect thereto.
