In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Six.

An Act reviving the Briggs and Allyn Manufacturing Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The Briggs and Allyn Manufacturing Company, a
2 corporation dissolved by chapter two hundred and
3 twelve of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty, is
4 hereby revived with the same powers, duties and obli-
5 gations as if the said chapter had not been passed.
