

HOUSE No. 40

Accompanying the second recommendation of the Police Commissioner for the City of Boston (House, No. 38). Legal Affairs. Dec. 3, 1925.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Six.

An Act prohibiting the Sale or Distribution of Magazines, Newspapers and Periodicals containing Advertisements of Firearms.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter two hundred and sixty-nine of the General
2 Laws is amended by adding the following new section
3 at the end of said chapter:—

4 *Section 14.* No magazine, newspaper or periodical
5 shall be sold, distributed or displayed for sale or dis-
6 tribution which contains advertisements relating to the
7 sale or lease of firearms as defined in section one hun-
8 dred and twenty-one of chapter one hundred and forty.
9 Any violation of this section shall be punished by a fine
10 of not more than fifty dollars.
