## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Six.

An Act to make Armistice Day a Legal Holiday.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section seven of chapter four of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended in paragraph eighteenth by adding after  
3 the word "twelfth", in the forty-eighth line of said  
4 section the following:— November eleventh,— so that  
5 said paragraph as amended will read as follows:—  
6 Eighteenth, "Legal holiday" shall include January first,  
7 February twenty-second, April nineteenth, May thirtieth,  
8 July fourth, the first Monday in September, October  
9 twelfth, November eleventh, Thanksgiving day and  
10 Christmas day, or the day following when any of the  
11 five days first mentioned, October twelfth or Christmas  
12 day occurs on Sunday; and the public offices shall be  
13 closed on all of said days.
