

By Mr. Birmingham of Boston, petition of Leo M. Birmingham that the Metropolitan District Commission be authorized to construct public bath houses on the Charles River Basin in the city of Boston. Metropolitan Affairs. Jan. 18.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Six.

An Act to provide for Public Bath Houses on the Charles River in the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commis-
2 sion is hereby authorized to construct and maintain
3 a public bath house on the south side of Charles
4 river north of the North Beacon street bridge, or
5 elsewhere in that neighborhood, as the commission
6 may deem expedient, and to use any land of the
7 commonwealth which is available therefor, and to
8 acquire by purchase or by right of eminent domain
9 such other land as may be necessary, and may ex-
10 pend in carrying out the provisions hereof, a sum
11 not exceeding dollars.

1 SECTION 2. The metropolitan district commis-
2 sion is hereby authorized to construct and maintain
3 a public bath house on the south side of Charles
4 river east of the Arsenal street bridge, or else-

5 where in that neighborhood, as the commission
6 may deem expedient, and to use any land of the
7 commonwealth which is available therefor, and to
8 acquire by purchase or by right of eminent domain
9 such other land as may be necessary, and may ex-
10 pend in carrying out the provisions hereof a sum
11 not exceeding dollars.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
