The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Six.

Resolutions memorializing the Senate of the United States to refuse Ratification of any Treaty or Agreement to Membership in the World Court or the League of Nations.

1 *Resolved*, That the general court of Massa-
2 chusetts hereby petitions the senate of the
3 United States to refuse and deny its ratifica-
4 tions and approval of any treaty, protocol, pact,
5 agreement or undertaking whereby the United
6 States would be admitted to membership in the
7 world court or the league of nations; and be it
8 further

9 *Resolved*, That copies of these resolutions be
10 sent to each of the senators in congress from
11 this commonwealth, and to the chairman of the
12 committee on foreign relations of the senate of
13 the United States.
