

HOUSE . . . No. 1027

By Mr. Birmingham of Boston, petition of Leo M. Birmingham that the city of Boston be authorized to incur indebtedness for the construction of a municipal building in the Brighton District. Municipal Finance. Jan. 22.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Six.

An Act to authorize the Construction of a Municipal Building in the Brighton District of the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of constructing a mu-
2 nicipal building in the Brighton district in the city of
3 Boston, said city may borrow from time to time, within
4 a period of five years from the passage of this act, such
5 sums as may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggre-
6 gate, four hundred and fifty thousand dollars, and may
7 issue bonds or notes therefor, which shall bear on their
8 face the words Brighton Municipal Building Loan, Act
9 of 1926. Each authorized issue shall constitute a
10 separate loan, and such loans shall be paid in not more
11 than fifteen years from their dates; but no issue shall
12 be authorized under this section unless a sum equal to
13 an amount not less than ten per cent of such author-
14 ized issue is voted for the same purpose to be raised by
15 the tax levy of the year when authorized. Indebtedness
16 incurred under this act shall be in excess of the statutory
17 limit, but shall, except as herein provided, be subject to

18 the laws relative to the issuance of debt by the city of
19 Boston. The proceeds of the loan herein authorized
20 shall be used only for the purposes herein specified.
21 The aforesaid municipal building shall be located on
22 land owned by the city in said district and shall be so
23 designed as, in the judgment of the city, to best serve the
24 community by providing quarters for municipal depart-
25 ments, for veteran and civic organizations that may
26 under the law be supplied by the city, auditorium, public
27 library branch, wardroom, gymnasium and baths and as
28 a community center.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its accept-
2 ance by vote of the city council of said city, subject to
3 the provisions of its charter; provided, that such accept-
4 ance occurs prior to December thirty-first in the current
5 year.
