1 *Ordered*, That the Division of Waterways and Public  
2 Lands of the Department of Public works be requested  
3 to continue the investigations, relative to the establish-  
4 ment of a free port within the Port of Boston, provided  
5 for by Chapter twenty-four of the Resolves of nineteen  
6 hundred and twenty-five; and, in the event of the pas-  
7 sage by Congress of the needed enabling legislation, said  
8 division is further requested to consider ways and  
9 means of establishing a free port pursuant to the terms  
10 of such legislation. Said division is requested to report  
11 on the subject matter of this order to the House of  
12 Representatives by filing the same with the Clerk not  
13 later than the first day of December in the current  
14 year.
