To accompany the petition of the Federation of State, City and Town Employees, by F. J. Dowd, president, relative to wages and salaries of certain employees of the sewer, water and park departments of the Metropolitan District Commission. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act relative to Wages and Salaries Paid to Certain Employees of the Sewer, Water and Park Departments of the Metropolitan District Commission.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The wages and salaries paid to laborers,
2 foremen, mechanics, engineers, oilers, firemen
3 and helpers in the employ of the sewer, water
4 and park departments of the metropolitan
5 district commission at the time this act takes
6 effect, whose wages or salaries were not in-
7 creased in the year nineteen hundred and
8 twenty-seven, shall thereupon be increased by
9 the sum of fifty cents per diem.
