

To accompany the petition of Henry L. Kincaide that provision be made for certain improvements at the Norfolk County Tuberculosis Hospital. Counties.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act providing for Certain Improvements at the Norfolk County Tuberculosis Hospital.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The county commissioners of the
2 county of Norfolk, acting as trustees of the Nor-
3 folk County Tuberculosis Hospital, may expend
4 a sum not exceeding fifty thousand dollars for the
5 purpose of constructing and originally equipping
6 and furnishing additions to said hospital which
7 shall be subject to the approval of the department
8 of public health, and may expend for the purpose
9 of extending the sewerage system of said hospital,
10 in addition to the sum authorized to be expended
11 for such purpose by section one of chapter one
12 hundred and thirty-two of the acts of nineteen
13 hundred and twenty-seven, the balance now re-
14 maining of the proceeds of the sale under chapter
15 twenty-two of the General Acts of nineteen hun-
16 dred and eighteen of certain land in the town of

17 Randolph originally purchased for the purpose of
18 a tuberculosis hospital in said county.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of constructing
2 and originally equipping and furnishing additions
3 to said hospital as aforesaid, the said county com-
4 missioners may borrow on the credit of the county
5 and issue notes of the county therefor to an
6 amount not exceeding fifty thousand dollars.
7 Such notes shall be payable by such annual pay-
8 ments beginning not more than one year after the
9 date thereof as will extinguish each loan within
10 five years from its date. The amount of such
11 annual payment in any one year shall not be less
12 than the amount of the principal of the loan
13 payable in any subsequent year. The notes shall
14 be signed by the county treasurer and counter-
15 signed by the county commissioners. Each au-
16 thorized issue shall constitute a separate loan.
17 All sums necessary to meet interest payments on
18 said notes and payments on account of principal
19 as the same mature shall be assessed upon the
20 cities and towns of said county constituting the
21 hospital district, in accordance with section
22 eighty-three of chapter one hundred and eleven of
23 the General Laws.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance by the county commissioners of the
3 county of Norfolk.
