

To accompany the petition of Ernest W. Haskell for legislation to authorize the assignment of a member of the Division of State Police at the request of the selectmen of a town. Public Safety.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act authorizing the Assignment of a Member of the Division of State Police at the Request of the Selectmen of a Town.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The selectmen of a town may request that a
2 member of the division of state police of the
3 department of public safety be assigned to per-
4 manent duty in any such town, and the commis-
5 sioner of public safety, in his discretion, may
6 assign a member of the said division in any such
7 town, and thereupon said commissioner may, in
8 his judgment, appoint an additional member of
9 said division in addition to the number of mem-
10 bers provided in section nine A of chapter
11 twenty-one of the General Laws; provided, that
12 upon making such request any such town shall
13 pay the salary and expenses of such member
14 during the period of duty, in the manner herein-
15 after specified. Such member, or additional
16 member of said division, assigned to duty as

17 aforesaid, shall, during the period of such duty,
18 continue to be a member of the division of state
19 police and subject to orders of said commis-
20 sioner, but his salary and expenses shall be paid by
21 any such town. The said commissioner shall
22 have full power at all times to withdraw any
23 member assigned to duty in any such town, and
24 to assign another member of said division in his
25 place, or to discontinue such duty and make no
26 assignment to replace said member.
