## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

---

An Act establishing the Salaries of the Justice, Clerk and Assistant Clerks of the Municipal Court of the Charlestown District.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section seventy-six of chapter two  
2 hundred and eighteen of the General Laws, as  
3 amended by section one of chapter three hundred  
4 and fifty-five of the acts of nineteen hundred and  
5 twenty-one and by section one of chapter four  
6 hundred and eighty-four and section one of  
7 chapter five hundred and five, both of the acts  
8 of nineteen hundred and twenty-four, and by  
9 section one of chapter two hundred and ninety-  
10 four of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-  
11 seven, is hereby further amended by striking out  
12 the second sentence thereof and inserting in place  
13 thereof the following sentence: — The salary of  
14 the justice of the municipal court of the Charles-  
15 town district shall be five thousand dollars., —

16 so as to read as follows:— *Section 76.* The  
17 salary of the justice of the Boston juvenile court  
18 shall be five thousand dollars, and that of the  
19 clerk of said court an amount equal to seventy-  
20 five per cent of the salary of the justice. The  
21 salary of the justice of the municipal court of  
22 the Charlestown district shall be five thousand  
23 dollars. The salary of the justice of the mu-  
24 nicipal court of the South Boston district shall be  
25 forty-five hundred dollars. The salaries of the  
26 justices of the following district courts shall  
27 severally be as follows: First district court of  
28 Barnstable, twenty-two hundred dollars; second  
29 district court of Essex, twenty-four hundred  
30 dollars; second district court of Plymouth,  
31 thirty-two hundred dollars; third district court  
32 of Plymouth, twenty-five hundred dollars; fourth  
33 district court of Plymouth, twenty-five hundred  
34 dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 acceptance by vote of the city council of the  
3 city of Boston, subject to the provisions of its  
4 charter; provided, that such acceptance occurs  
5 during the current year.
