In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act authorizing the City of Haverhill to reimburse Albert L. Bartlett for Expenses incurred while acting as an Official thereof.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of discharging a
2 moral obligation, the city of Haverhill may pay
3 to Albert L. Bartlett a sum of money not exceed-
4 ing fifteen hundred dollars to reimburse him for
5 expenses and costs of litigation incurred in the
6 course of defending a suit brought against him
7 as an individual for certain acts done in the per-
8 formance of his duties while an alderman of said
9 city and while acting as commissioner of public
10 safety therein.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance during the current year by vote of
3 the municipal council of the said city, subject to
4 the provisions of its charter; otherwise it shall
5 not take effect.
