

To accompany the petition of Horace B. Parker that the salary of the superintendent of the State Arsenal be established. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act establishing the Salary of the Superintendent of the State Arsenal.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section eighty-three of chapter
2 thirty-three of the General Laws, as appearing in
3 chapter four hundred and sixty-five of the acts
4 of nineteen hundred and twenty-four, is hereby
5 amended by striking out, in the fourth line, the
6 word "fifteen" and inserting in place thereof
7 the word: — twenty-five, — so that the second
8 sentence of said section will read as follows: —
9 An officer of the quartermaster corps of the land
10 forces of suitable grade, detailed to act as super-
11 intendent of the state arsenal, shall receive twenty-
12 five hundred dollars a year, except when ordered
13 on duty under section twenty-five or twenty-six
14 and shall be in the quartermaster corps of the
15 land forces as a clerk in addition to the clerks
16 hereinafter provided for.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect when an
2 appropriation sufficient to cover the same has
3 been made, and then as of the first day of
4 in the current year.
