

Accompanying the third recommendation of the Acting Commissioner of Insurance. Insurance.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Nine.

An Act to prohibit the Printing or Publication of Advertisements for or on Behalf of Unlicensed Insurance Companies and Fraternal Benefit Societies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred and sev-
2 enty-five of the General Laws is hereby
3 amended by inserting after section one hun-
4 dred and sixty the following new section:—

5 *Section 160A.* No person shall print or pub-
6 lish, or cause to be printed or published in any
7 newspaper or other periodical any advertise-
8 ment for or on behalf of any foreign company
9 not authorized to transact business in this com-
10 monwealth, or any circular or poster of any
11 kind containing such an advertisement. No
12 person shall transmit or publish any ad-
13 vertisement for or on behalf of any such
14 company from any radio broadcasting sta-
15 tion located in the commonwealth. Who-
16 ever violates this section shall, except as pro-

17 vided in section forty-nine A of chapter one
18 hundred and seventy-six, be punished by a fine
19 of not less than fifty nor more than five hun-
20 dred dollars.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter one hundred and sev-
2 enty-six of the General Laws is hereby
3 amended by inserting after section forty-nine
4 the following new section:—

5 *Section 49A.* No person shall print or pub-
6 lish, or cause to be printed or published in any
7 newspaper or other periodical any advertise-
8 ment for or on behalf of any fraternal benefit
9 society not authorized to transact business in
10 this commonwealth, or any circular or poster
11 of any kind containing such an advertisement.
12 No person shall transmit or publish any
13 advertisement for or on behalf of any such
14 society from any radio broadcasting station
15 located in the commonwealth. Whoever vio-
16 lates this section shall be punished by a fine of
17 not less than fifty nor more than five hundred
18 dollars.
