

HOUSE No. 270

By Mr. Crowley of Chelsea, petition of Frank D. Crowley that the fees for substitute registrations of motor vehicles be reduced. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Nine.

An Act reducing the Fees for substituting Registrations of Motor Vehicles for those of Motor Vehicles previously registered.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section thirty-three of chapter ninety of the
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by
3 section five of chapter three hundred and six-
4 teen of the acts of nineteen hundred and
5 twenty-eight, is hereby further amended by
6 striking out, in the third line of the fifteenth
7 paragraph, the words "two dollars" and
8 inserting in place thereof the words:—sixty
9 cents,—and by striking out, in the third line
10 of the sixteenth paragraph, the words "one
11 dollar" and inserting in place thereof the
12 words:—thirty cents,—so that said fifteenth
13 and sixteenth paragraphs will read as follows:
14 For the substitution of the registration of

15 an automobile for that of a vehicle previously
16 registered, in accordance with section two,
17 sixty cents.

18 For the substitution of the registration of a
19 motor cycle for that of a vehicle previously
20 registered, in accordance with section two,
21 thirty cents.
