**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Nine.

An Act establishing the Salary of the Deputy Commissioner of State Aid and Pensions.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section twenty-four of chapter six of the  
2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking  
3 out in the third line the word " twenty-seven "   
4 and inserting in place thereof the word:—  
5 thirty-two, — so as to read as follows:— *Sec-*  
6 *tion 24.* The governor, with the advice and  
7 consent of the council, shall appoint a deputy  
8 commissioner of state aid and pensions for three  
9 years, at a salary of thirty-two hundred dollars,  
10 who shall devote his whole time to the duties  
11 of his office. He shall be subject to the direc-  
12 tion and control of the commissioner, and shall  
13 perform the duties of the commissioner during  
14 his absence on account of disability or other  
15 cause.
