## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Nine.

An Act relative to the Repeal of Penalty imposing Fine of not less than Ten nor more than Fifty Dollars for Violation of Weekly Payment Law and substituting Sentence of Imprisonment of Thirty Days.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter one hundred and forty-nine, section  
2 one hundred and forty-eight of the General  
3 Laws, as amended by chapter one hundred and  
4 sixty-five of the acts of nineteen hundred and  
5 twenty-five is hereby further amended by strik-  
6 ing out the last sentence in said section and  
7 inserting in place thereof the following:—  
8 Whoever violates this section shall be punished  
9 by imprisonment of thirty days.
