An Act relative to the Filing of Certificates of Increase of
Capital Stock of Certain Miscellaneous Corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section thirty-nine of chapter one hundred and
2 fifty-eight of the General Laws is hereby amended
3 by adding at the end thereof the following new
4 sentence: — If such a certificate is not filed as afore-
5 said within said period of thirty days, it may there-
6 after be received by the commissioner for examination
7 in accordance with section forty-one upon payment
8 to him of such sum, not exceeding twenty-five dollars,
9 as he may determine, and be filed as hereinbefore
10 provided, subject to the provisions of sections forty-
11 one and forty-three to the same extent as if such
12 certificate had been filed as aforesaid within said
13 period.
