The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Nine.

An Act authorizing and directing the Metropolitan District Commission to construct and maintain an Underpass or Overpass to carry the Traffic on Revere Beach Parkway across Broadway in the City of Revere.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby
2 authorized and directed to construct and maintain an
3 underpass or overpass for foot and vehicular traffic
4 on the Revere Beach Parkway at the junction of said
5 parkway with Broadway in the city of Revere, and
6 may expend therefor such sum, not exceeding ninety
7 thousand dollars, as may hereafter be appropriated.
8 One third of the expenditures made under authority
9 of this act shall be paid by the commonwealth; one
10 third shall be paid by the cities and towns of the metro-
11 politan parks district including the city of Revere, as
12 part of the cost of maintenance of boulevards under
13 section fifty-six of chapter ninety-two of the General
14 Laws; and the remaining one third shall be paid by the
15 city of Revere.
