## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Nine.

Resolve providing for an Investigation by the Metropolitan District Commission with Reference to the Widening or Reconstruction of Saugus River Bridge between the Point of Pines and the City of Lynn.

1     *Resolved*, That the metropolitan district commission  
2 is hereby directed to investigate the desirability of  
3 widening or reconstructing the Saugus river bridge,  
4 connecting Lynnway at the Point of Pines with the  
5 city of Lynn, and to report thereon to the general  
6 court on or the first Wednesday of December, nineteen  
7 hundred and twenty-nine. Said commission shall in-  
8 clude in its report its recommendations as to whether  
9 the bridge should be widened or reconstructed, the  
10 cost of both widening and reconstructing the same,  
11 how the cost of such widening or reconstruction should  
12 be paid, and such further information and recom-  
13 mendations as said commission deems necessary or  
14 desirable.
