Mr. Finnegan of Boston presented a petition of Jeremiah Connors for an amendment of the law limiting the height of buildings on and near Copley Square in the city of Boston in respect to buildings on land abutting on St. James Avenue between Clarendon Street and Trinity Place. Mercantile Affairs.

An Act relative to the Height of Buildings on Land abutting on St. James Avenue between Clarendon Street and Trinity Place in the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section one of chapter four hundred and fifty-two
2 of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-
3 eight is hereby amended by adding thereto the
4 following:— And provided further, however, that
5 the height limit of ninety feet on land abutting on
6 St. James avenue between Clarendon street and
7 Trinity place shall apply only to any building or
8 portion of a building within one hundred feet of
9 St. James avenue.
