

HOUSE No. 310

By Mr. Hays of Boston, petition of Martin Hays and Leo M. Birmingham for the appointment of an additional court officer for the municipal court of the Brighton district of the city of Boston. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty.

An Act authorizing the Appointment of an Additional Court Officer for the Municipal Court of the Brighton District of the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section sixty-two of chapter two hun-
2 dred and eighteen of the General Laws, as most
3 recently amended by section one of chapter two
4 hundred and eight of the acts of nineteen hundred
5 and twenty-nine, is hereby further amended by
6 inserting after the word "district", the second time
7 it appears in the tenth line, the words:—, of the
8 Brighton district,—so as to read as follows:—
9 *Section 62.* In the municipal court of the city of
10 Boston the court officers appointed shall not exceed
11 ten for criminal business and five for civil business
12 and one of such court officers for criminal business
13 shall be designated by the chief justice as chief court
14 officer of said court for criminal business, and one of

15 such court officers for criminal business shall be
16 designated as an assistant chief court officer; in the
17 municipal court of the Roxbury district four court
18 officers may be appointed; in the municipal court
19 of the South Boston district, of the Charlestown
20 district, of the Brighton district and of the West
21 Roxbury district, the East Boston district court, the
22 district court of Chelsea, the third district court
23 of eastern Middlesex and the district court of East
24 Norfolk two court officers for each court may be ap-
25 pointed; and in each of the other district courts in
26 the commonwealth one court officer may be appointed.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance, during the current year, by vote of the
3 city council of the city of Boston, subject to the
4 provisions of its charter, but not otherwise.
