The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty.

Resolve providing for an Investigation by the Massachusetts Industrial Commission of Conditions in and Affecting the Shoe and Leather Industry in this Commonwealth.

1 That the Massachusetts industrial commission,
2 established by chapter three hundred and fifty-seven
3 of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, is
4 hereby authorized and directed to investigate condi-
5 tions in and affecting the shoe and leather industry
6 in this commonwealth, with a view to devising ways
7 and means to effect an improvement of such conditions.
8 Said commission shall report to the general court the
9 results of its investigation, its recommendations, if
10 any, together with drafts of legislation to carry the
11 same into effect, by filing the same with the clerk
12 of the house of representatives on or before the first
13 Wednesday of December of the current year. For
14 the purpose of this act, the commission may expend,
15 after an appropriation has been made, such sum, not
16 exceeding ten thousand dollars, as may be approved
17 by the governor and council.
