

HOUSE No. 544

By Mr. Cahill of Braintree, petition of Horace T. Cahill that the Metropolitan District Commission be authorized to construct a boulevard or parkway from Administration Road in the Blue Hills Reservation to Willard Street in the city of Quincy and town of Braintree. Metropolitan Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty.

An Act to authorize the Metropolitan District Commission to Lay Out and Construct a Boulevard or Parkway from Administration Road to Willard Street in the City of Quincy and Town of Braintree.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission
2 is hereby authorized to lay out and construct a boulev-
3 vard or parkway in accordance with the provisions
4 of chapter ninety-two of the General Laws, relative
5 to the laying out and constructing of parkways or
6 boulevards, in the city of Quincy and town of Brain-
7 tree, from Administration road at or near its junction
8 with Wampatuck road, Blue Hills reservation to
9 Willard street in the town of Braintree, and may
10 expend therefor such sum not exceeding
11 dollars as may hereafter be appropriated.

1 SECTION 2. One half of the expenditures made
2 under authority of this act shall be paid by the cities
3 and towns of the metropolitan parks district as part
4 of the cost of maintenance of boulevards under section
5 fifty-six of chapter ninety-two of the General Laws,
6 and the remaining half shall be paid from the highway
7 fund.

1 SECTION 3. The commission may, on behalf of
2 the commonwealth, take by eminent domain or ac-
3 quire by purchase or otherwise such private lands
4 as it may deem necessary for carrying out the pro-
5 visions of this act.
