

By Mr. Mahoney of Boston, petition of Francis F. Morse relative to the classification and salaries of certain employees serving on the bridges under the control of the Metropolitan District Commission. Ways and Means.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty.

An Act relative to the Classification and Salaries of Certain Employees serving on the Bridges in the Control of the Metropolitan District Commission.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of sections forty-five to
2 fifty, inclusive, of chapter thirty of the General Laws
3 shall not apply to the employees of the metropolitan
4 district commission serving on the bridges under its
5 control.

1 SECTION 2. Said employees shall be classified in
2 the following groups and shall receive the following
3 maximum and minimum salaries, as determined by the
4 commission:—

GROUP.	Minimum Salary.	Maximum Salary.
Head lock and draw tenders (formerly head lock and draw operators).	\$1,800	\$2,200
Lock and draw tenders (formerly lock and draw operators)	1,700	1,950
Assistant lock and draw tenders (formerly lock and draw helpers).	1,600	1,800
Mechanical handy men	1,600	1,800
