By Mr. Crockwell of Medford, petition of Richard D. Crockwell for the establishment of a board of license commissioners in the city of Medford. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty.

An Act to establish a Board of License Commissioners
in the City of Medford.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 There is hereby established in the city of Medford
2 a board of license commissioners, to consist of the
3 chiefs of police and fire departments of the city and
4 the third commissioner to be appointed by the mayor,
5 subject to the provisions of the city charter, for a
6 term of two years. All authority to grant licenses
7 now or hereafter vested by law in board of aldermen
8 in cities shall, upon its organization, be exercised in
9 said city by the board of license commissioners ex-
10 clusively. The commissioner appointed by the mayor
11 shall be chairman of the board and shall receive such
12 compensation as the mayor and city council shall
13 determine.
