

By Mr. Crowley of Chelsea, petition of Frank D. Crowley relative to the tenure of office of the city messenger of the city of Chelsea. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty.

An Act relative to the Tenure of Office of the City Messenger of the City of Chelsea.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city messenger of the city of
2 Chelsea in office at the time this act takes effect and
3 any person thereafter elected to fill any vacancy
4 existing in such office shall hold office during good
5 behavior and until removed by the board of alder-
6 men in accordance with the provisions of chapter
7 thirty-one of the General 'Laws and the rules and
8 regulations made thereunder relative to removals
9 from classified public service. After this act takes
10 effect, any vacancy in the office of city messenger
11 in said city shall be filled by election by ballot by its
12 board of aldermen.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance by vote of the board of aldermen of said
3 city, subject to the provisions of its charter; provided,
4 that such acceptance occurs prior to December
5 thirty-first in the current year.
