

HOUSE No. 747

By Mr. Crowley of Chelsea, petition of Frank D. Crowley for the establishment of a county government for the county of Suffolk Counties.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty.

An Act establishing a County Government for
the County of Suffolk.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section four of chapter thirty-
2 four of the General Laws is hereby amended
3 by striking out the words " and Suffolk " in
4 the first line thereof, and by striking out all
5 after the word " Nantucket " in the ninth,
6 tenth, eleventh, twelfth and thirteenth lines of
7 said section four. Section five of said chapter
8 is hereby amended by striking out the words
9 " Suffolk and " in the second line of said sec-
10 tion. Section seven of said chapter is hereby
11 amended by striking out all of said section
12 after the word " way " in the fourth line
13 thereof.

14 Section one of chapter thirty-five of the
15 General Laws is hereby amended by striking
16 out of the first line thereof the words " in

17 Suffolk county the treasurer of Boston and ”.
18 Section thirty-seven of said chapter thirty-five
19 is hereby amended by striking out of the thir-
20 tenth line thereof the words “ Suffolk and ”.
21 Section one hundred and fifty-eight of chap-
22 ter fifty-four of the General Laws is hereby
23 amended by striking out the words “ and of
24 Revere and Winthrop ” in the third line there-
25 of and the words “ Suffolk and ” in the fifth
26 line thereof, and by striking out the words
27 “ and of Revere and Winthrop ” in the eighth
28 and ninth lines thereof, and by striking out the
29 words “ Suffolk and ” in the tenth line thereof,
30 and by striking out the words “ and of Revere
31 and Winthrop ” in the fourteenth line thereof,
32 and by striking out the words “ Suffolk and ”
33 in the sixteenth line thereof.

1 SECTION 2. In the year nineteen hundred
2 and twenty-six there shall be elected three
3 county commissioners, two of whom shall hold
4 office for the term of four years, and one of
5 whom shall hold office for the term of two years;
6 and thereafter their successors shall be elected
7 in accordance with the General Laws.
