By Mr. Birmingham of Boston, petition of Leo M. Birmingham that the Metropolitan District Commission be authorized to construct a beach and bath houses on the Charles River Basin in the Faneuil and Brighton districts of the city of Boston. Metropolitan Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

An Act providing for the Construction of Certain Beaches on the Charles River and the Construction and Maintenance of Bath Houses thereon.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby
2 authorized and directed to construct a beach on the
3 Charles river in the Faneuil district and in the North
4 Brighton district of the city of Boston and to con-
5 struct and maintain on each of said beaches a public
6 bath house. For said purposes there may be expended
7 such sums not exceeding dollars, as may
8 hereafter be appropriated.
