## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty.

An Act authorizing the City of Worcester to borrow Money for the Purpose of Constructing a Municipal Memorial Auditorium.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Worcester may incur in-  
2 debtedness for the construction of a municipal audi-  
3 torium as a memorial to soldiers, sailors and marines,  
4 and may, within a period of five years from the pas-  
5 sage of this act, issue bonds or notes therefor, which  
6 shall bear on their face the words, Worcester Mu-  
7 nicipal Memorial Auditorium Loan, Act of 1930.  
8 Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate  
9 loan, and such loans shall be payable in not more  
10 than ten years from their dates, but no loan shall be  
11 authorized under this act unless a sum equal to an  
12 amount not less than ten per cent of the loan so au-  
13 thorized is voted for the same purpose to be provided  
14 from taxes or other sources of revenue of the year  
15 when authorized. Indebtedness incurred under this  
16 act shall be in excess of the amount authorized by  
17 chapter two hundred and eleven of the Special Acts  
18 of nineteen hundred and sixteen, as amended by  
19 chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the acts of

20 nineteen hundred and twenty, but shall, except as  
21 provided herein, be subject to chapter forty-four of  
22 the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
