

By Mr. Bigelow of Brookline (by request), petition of George M. Kline that the Department of Mental Diseases be authorized to acquire additional land in the city of Waltham and the towns of Belmont and Lexington for the Metropolitan State Hospital. Public Institutions.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty.

An Act authorizing the Department of Mental Diseases to take or purchase Additional Land in the City of Waltham and the Towns of Belmont and Lexington for the Proposed Metropolitan State Hospital.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of mental diseases, on behalf of
2 the commonwealth, may, during the year nineteen
3 hundred and thirty, with the approval of the governor
4 and council, take in fee by eminent domain under
5 chapter seventy-nine of the General Laws, or acquire
6 by purchase, for the proposed metropolitan state
7 hospital, land in the city of Waltham and in the towns
8 of Belmont and Lexington, adjoining land already
9 acquired by the commonwealth for said proposed
10 hospital, and may expend therefor such sums already
11 appropriated in item number four hundred and forty-
12 four of chapter number one hundred and fifteen of
13 the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty as may be
14 approved by the governor.
