## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty.

An Act providing that, in a Certain Event, the Board of Water Commissioners of the Town of Weymouth shall act as a Board of Sewer Commissioners upon Said Town's becoming a Member of the South Metropolitan Sewerage District.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Upon acceptance by the town of  
2 Weymouth of any act providing for the admission of  
3 said town to the south metropolitan sewerage dis-  
4 trict, the board of water commissioners of said town,  
5 established by chapter one hundred and seventy-four  
6 of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty-one, shall,  
7 if said town has not prior to such acceptance estab-  
8 lished a board of sewer commissioners or provided that  
9 the selectmen act as such, possess all the powers and  
10 be subject to all the duties of a board of sewer com-  
11 missioners under any law now or hereafter in force;  
12 provided, that nothing in this act shall prevent said  
13 town from thereafter establishing a board of sewer  
14 commissioners or providing that the selectmen act as  
15 such, in either of which cases the powers and duties  
16 hereby conferred and imposed upon said board of

17 water commissioners shall thereupon be transferred  
18 to said board of sewer commissioners or board of  
19 selectmen, as the case may be.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
