To accompany the petition of Wegea H. H. Tracy, clerk, New England Anti-Vivisection Society, and Frank Hurley that certain experiments and operations on live dogs be penalized. Legal Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Three.

An Act penalizing Certain Experiments and Operations
on Live Dogs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter two hundred and seventy-two of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
3 section eighty B, inserted by section one of chapter
4 three hundred and forty-seven of the acts of nine-
5 teen hundred and twenty-eight, the following new
6 section: —

7 *Section 80C.* Whoever experiments or operates
8 in any manner whatsoever upon a live dog for any
9 purpose other than the healing or curing of such
10 dog shall, except as provided in section eighty A,
11 be punished by a fine of not less than one hundred
12 nor more than five hundred dollars, or by imprison-
13 ment for not less than three months nor more than
14 one year, or by both.
