

SENATE No. 180

To accompany the petition of David F. Sullivan and others that provision be made for party nominations for elective municipal officers in the city of Holyoke. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Three.

An Act providing for Party Nominations for Elective Municipal Officers in the City of Holyoke.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Nominations of candidates for
2 municipal elective office in the city of Holyoke
3 shall be made by nomination papers as provided
4 in section six of chapter fifty-three of the Gen-
5 eral Laws and by political parties in primaries
6 held in accordance with the provisions of sections
7 twenty-three to forty and fifty-seven to sixty-
8 four, all inclusive, of said chapter fifty-three.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted to
2 the registered voters of said city at the next
3 following municipal election in the form of the
4 following question which shall be placed on the
5 official ballot for use in said city at said election:
6 — “Shall an act passed by the general court in

7 the year nineteen hundred and thirty-three,
8 entitled 'An Act providing for party nominations
9 for elective municipal officers in the city of
10 Holyoke' be accepted?" If a majority of the
11 votes cast on said question are in the affirmative,
12 the provisions of section one of this act shall
13 thereupon take effect, but not otherwise.
