## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Three.

### An Act making Vaccination Voluntary.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. No person shall be required to  
2 submit to any form of vaccination or inocula-  
3 tion as a condition precedent to admission to  
4 any school, institution of learning or public in-  
5 stitution, nor to the exercise of any right, per-  
6 formance of any duty, or enjoyment of any  
7 privilege.

1 SECTION 2. Section fifteen of chapter seventy-  
2 six and section one hundred and eighty-one to  
3 one hundred and eighty-three, inclusive, of chap-  
4 ter one hundred and eleven of the General Laws  
5 and all acts in amendment thereof and in addi-  
6 tion thereto are hereby repealed.
