## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

Resolutions memorializing Congress in Favor of Legislation providing for Appropriation of Moneys for the Benefit of the Home Owners' Loan Corporation.

1 *Whereas*, The Home Owners' Loan Corporation  
2 has effectively operated to relieve the small home  
3 owners from the possibilities of foreclosure; and

4 *Whereas*, The Home Owners' Loan Corporation has  
5 secured the liquidation of so-called frozen assets; and

6 *Whereas*, Because of lack of funds the Home Owners'  
7 Loan Corporation can no longer function for the  
8 purposes for which it was intended; therefore be it

9 *Resolved*, That The General Court of Massachusetts  
10 hereby respectfully memorializes the Congress of the  
11 United States to enact the necessary legislation for  
12 the purpose of the appropriation of moneys to be  
13 transferred to the Home Owners' Loan Corporation  
14 so that it can continue to operate for the purpose  
15 of alleviating the burdens of the small home owners.

16 *Resolved*, That a copy of these resolutions be sent  
17 by the Secretary of the Commonwealth to each such  
18 member of the Congress from Massachusetts.
