By Mr. Barnet of New Bedford, petition of Philip Barnet for repeal of the act of 1932 imposing an additional tax of one cent a gallon on sales of gasoline. Taxation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

An Act repealing the Additional Excise Tax of One Cent Imposed on Each Gallon of Gasoline sold in the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred and forty-
2 eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-two,
3 extending the time during which there shall be col-
4 lected an additional excise tax of one cent on each
5 gallon of gasoline sold in the commonwealth, is
6 hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on May
2 first, nineteen hundred and thirty-five.
