The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

An Act increasing the Number of Associate Justices of the Municipal Court of the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section fifty of chapter two hundred and eighteen
2 of the General Laws, as appearing in the Ter-
3 centenary edition, is hereby amended by striking
4 out, in the second line, the word "eight" and insert-
5 ing in place thereof the word:— eleven, — so as to
6 read as follows:— *Section 50.* The municipal court
7 of the city of Boston shall consist of one chief justice,
8 eleven associate justices and six special justices.
9 Said court may from time to time make rules for
10 regulating the practice and conducting the business
11 therein in all cases not expressly provided for by law.
