## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

An Act extending the Time for the Acceptance by the Voters of the Town of Norwell of an Act authorizing Said Town to supply itself and its Inhabitants with Water.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section ten of chapter one hundred and forty-  
2 nine of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-one  
3 is hereby amended by striking out, in the fourth  
4 line, the word "three" and inserting in place thereof  
5 the word:—six,—so as to read as follows:—  
6 *Section 10.* This act shall take effect upon its ac-  
7 ceptance by a majority of the voters of the town  
8 of Norwell present and voting thereon at a town  
9 meeting called for the purpose within six years  
10 after its passage; but the number of meetings so  
11 called in any year shall not exceed three; and, for  
12 the purpose only of being submitted to the voters  
13 of said town as aforesaid, this act shall take effect  
14 upon its passage.
