Resolutions commending the President of the United States for his Courage in Urging Congress to take the Profits Out of War, and requesting that the President and Congress take the Profits Out of Munitions in Preparedness for War.

1 *Whereas*, The president of the United States has  
2 courageously recommended legislation looking to  
3 the taking of private profits out of war; and

4 *Whereas*, Private profits in war munitions may  
5 be an incentive to warfare and retard the con-  
6 tinuance of peace on earth and good will to man;  
7 therefore, be it

8 *Resolved*, That the general court of Massachu-  
9 setts hereby commends the president of the United  
10 States for his courage and leadership above men-  
11 tioned, and earnestly and respectfully requests the  
12 president and congress to further the cause of  
13 removing private profits from war and from muni-  
14 tions in preparedness for war; and be it further

15 *Resolved*, That copies of these resolutions be  
 16 transmitted forthwith by the secretary of the com-  
 17 monwealth to the president of the United States,  
 18 to the presiding officers of both branches of congress,  
 19 and to the representatives in congress from this  
 20 commonwealth.
