By Mr. Bourgeois of Lowell (by request), petition of the Massachusetts Veterinary Medical Society for amendment of the law relative to the slaughtering of neat cattle, sheep and swine. Public Health.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

An Act relative to the Business of Slaughtering Neat Cattle, Sheep or Swine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section one hundred and nineteen of chapter
2 ninety-four of the General Laws, as appearing in
3 the Tercentenary edition, is hereby amended by
4 adding at the end thereof the following: —

5 The department of public health is hereby author-
6 ized to make rules and regulations as to the sanitary
7 conditions under which such establishments shall be
8 constructed and operated. The aldermen, selectmen
9 or such officers, board of health granting the licenses
10 under this section or the department of public health
11 may suspend or revoke such licenses if the establish-
12 ment is constructed, operated or maintained in viola-
13 tion of such regulations.
