

HOUSE No. 1044

By Mr. Valentine of Chelmsford, petition of Harold C. Petterson and others that the North Chelmsford Fire District be authorized to extend its boundaries and to make an additional water loan. Water Supply.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

An Act extending the Boundaries of the North Chelmsford Fire District and authorizing said District to make an Additional Water Loan.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The boundaries of the north Chelmsford
2 fire district established by chapter one hundred and
3 nineteen of the acts of nineteen hundred and six, and
4 extended by section one of chapter three hundred and
5 fourteen of the acts of nineteen hundred and ten and by
6 section one of chapter forty of the acts of nineteen
7 hundred and twenty-six, are hereby extended so as to
8 include the three different parcels of land described
9 in this section and the inhabitants of the town of
10 Chelmsford liable to taxation in said town and resid-
11 ing in the territory included in said parcels: — The
12 first parcel is situated west of the present fire dis-
13 trict, adjoining the same and bounded and described
14 as follows: Beginning at a point in the westerly line

15 of the district three hundred feet distant northerly
16 from the northerly line of the Groton road; thence
17 running westerly and northwesterly in a line parallel
18 with and distant three hundred feet northerly from
19 the northerly side of the Groton road to the Westford
20 town line; thence turning and running in a straight
21 line southeasterly to the westerly line of premises of
22 Joseph Locapo on the southerly side of the West
23 Chelmsford road; thence running southerly by the
24 westerly line of the premises of Joseph Locapo three
25 hundred feet; thence turning and running easterly in
26 a line parallel with and three hundred feet distant
27 from the southerly side of the West Chelmsford road
28 to a point opposite the intersection of the West
29 Chelmsford road with the Groton road; thence turn-
30 ing and running easterly in a line parallel with and
31 three hundred feet distant from the southerly side of
32 the Groton road to the westerly line of the district;
33 thence turning and running northerly by the westerly
34 line of the district to the point of beginning. The
35 second parcel adjoins the present fire district on the
36 southwest and is bounded and described as follows:
37 Beginning at the northeasterly corner of the present
38 district as extended by the third parcel described in
39 section one of chapter three hundred and fourteen of
40 the acts of nineteen hundred and ten; thence running
41 northwesterly by the line of the Merrimack river to
42 the Tyngsborough town line at the Merrimack river;
43 thence turning and running southwest by the
44 Tyngsborough town line to the present line of the
45 district at the Dunstable road; thence turning and
46 running northeasterly by the line of the present dis-
47 trict to the point of beginning. The third parcel
48 adjoins the present fire district on the southwest, and

49 is bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a
50 point in the southwesterly line of the present district
51 at a Chelmsford-Tyngsborough town bound on the
52 southwesterly side of the Old Tyngsborough road near
53 the intersection of the Dunstable road; thence turn-
54 ing and running southwesterly by the Chelmsford-
55 Tyngsborough town line to a point three hundred feet
56 distant in a perpendicular line from the southwesterly
57 line of the Dunstable road and line of the present
58 district; thence running in a southeasterly direction
59 to a district stone bound on the northwesterly side of
60 the district near the Groton road at Crystal lake;
61 thence running by the southwesterly side of the
62 present district to the point of beginning.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of meeting the ex-
2 pense of laying mains and pipes in the district as
3 extended by this act, said district may borrow from
4 time to time such sums as may be necessary, not
5 exceeding in the aggregate twenty-three thousand
6 dollars, and may issue bonds or notes therefor, which
7 shall bear on their face the words, North Chelmsford
8 Fire District Loan, Act of 1935. Each authorized
9 issue shall constitute a separate loan, and such loans
10 shall be payable in not more than thirty years from
11 their dates. Indebtedness incurred under this act
12 shall be subject to chapter forty-four of the General
13 Laws.

1 SECTION 3. The said district shall, at the time of
2 authorizing the said loan or loans, provide for the
3 payment thereof in accordance with section two of
4 this act; and when a vote to that effect has been
5 passed, a sum which, with the income derived from

6 water rates, will be sufficient to pay the annual ex-
7 pense of operating the water works and interest as it
8 accrues on bonds or notes issued as aforesaid, and to
9 make such payments on the principal as may be re-
10 quired under this act, shall without further vote, be
11 assessed upon the said district by the assessors of the
12 town of Chelmsford annually thereafter until the debt
13 incurred by said loan or loans is extinguished.

1 SECTION 4. The board of water commissioners,
2 shall, in each year in which a tax is duly voted by said
3 district, prepare a list of the real estate in the dis-
4 trict, as extended by this act, which is so situated that
5 it can receive no aid in the extinguishment of fire from
6 the said system of water supply, or, which is so situ-
7 ated that the buildings thereon or the buildings that
8 might be constructed thereon in any ordinary or
9 reasonable manner could not be supplied with water
10 from the said system; and the clerk, when he sends
11 a certified copy of the vote authorizing a tax levy to
12 the assessors of said town, shall also send a certified
13 copy of the list of real estate made by the board of
14 water commissioners as herein provided, and no real
15 estate listed as aforesaid shall be subject to any tax
16 assessed on account of the system of water supply for
17 the year in which said list is certified.

1 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
