

HOUSE No. 1130

By Mr. Paul of Canton, petition of Charles J. Draper of Boston that the Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission be authorized to refund to him a certain license fee. Legal Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

Resolve authorizing the Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission to order the Refunding of a Certain License Fee to Charles J. Draper of Boston.

1 *Resolved*, That the alcoholic beverages control com-
2 mission may order refunded to Charles J. Draper of
3 Boston, doing business as Gray-Draper Company,
4 who applied for and was issued a license from said
5 commission on or about February tenth, nineteen
6 hundred and thirty-four under chapter three hundred
7 and seventy-six of the acts of the year nineteen hun-
8 dred and thirty-three, a part of the fee paid by him
9 for such license, said Charles Draper having exercised
10 no right, power or privilege under said chapter three
11 hundred and seventy-six subsequent to June twenty-
12 third, nineteen hundred and thirty-four. Said part of
13 the fee to be refunded to be proportionate to that part
14 of the year nineteen hundred and thirty-four subse-
15 quent to said June twenty-third, nineteen hundred
16 and thirty-four. Any sums ordered refunded as
17 aforesaid may be paid from moneys on hand received
18 by said commission under said chapter three hundred
19 and seventy-six, or without appropriation, from the
20 state treasury, from moneys paid thereunto under
21 section twenty-seven of said chapter, upon order of
22 the said commission certified by the comptroller.
