An Act adjusting and amending Requirements for Old Age Assistance.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Any person who owns real estate shall be entitled
- 2 to old age assistance, whose equity does not exceed
- 3 four thousand dollars based on assessed valuations
- 4 for taxation purposes of nineteen hundred and
- 5 thirty-three and have no other funds.
