

By Mr. Small of Truro (by request), petition of Charles M. Norris that transportation in motor trucks of agricultural products from farms to markets be made exempt from certain laws relative to motor trucking. Transportation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

An Act providing for Exemption from the Requirements of Certain Laws of Persons engaged in the Transportation of Agricultural Products from the Farm of the Producer of Such Products to the Market.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hundred
2 and fifty-nine B of the General Laws is hereby amended
3 by inserting after the word "person" in the second
4 line of said section the words:— other than those
5 engaged in the transportation of agricultural products
6 from the place of production of such products to the
7 market.

1 SECTION 2. Section three of said chapter one hun-
2 dred and fifty-nine B is hereby further amended by
3 adding at the end of the first sentence of said section
4 the following words:— and other than a person en-
5 gaged in the transportation of agricultural products
6 from the place of production of such products to the
7 market.
