Resolve in Favor of Anna B. Noseworthy.

1 *Resolved*, That for the purpose of discharging
2 the moral obligation of the commonwealth in the
3 premises, there be allowed and paid out of the
4 treasury of the commonwealth, after an appropria-
5 tion has been made therefor, the sum of one hun-
6 dred and thirteen dollars to Anna B. Noseworthy
7 to reimburse her for the expense of hospital and
8 medical care necessarily incurred by her on account
9 of injuries sustained at Camp Devens as a result
10 of the negligence of certain members of the Massa-
11 chusetts national guard.
