
By Mr. Morris of Everett (by request), petition of Morris Berzon for investigation and study by a special unpaid commission (including members of the General Court) of the sale and distribution of alcoholic beverages in the several States. Rules (concurrently).

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

Resolve providing for an Investigation and Study by a Commission of the Sale and Distribution of Alcoholic Beverages.

1 *Resolved*, That a special unpaid commission is
2 hereby established, to consist of one senator, to be
3 designated by the president of the senate, three
4 representatives, to be designated by the speaker of
5 the house of representatives, and three members to
6 be appointed by the governor, with the advice and
7 consent of the council, for the purpose of investigat-
8 ing and studying the sale and distribution of alco-
9 holic beverages in the several states of the union.
10 The commission shall devote special time to the
11 study of those states that have adopted the public
12 operated, managed or controlled method of selling,
13 distributing or dispensing alcoholic beverages. It
14 shall report to the general court its findings and
15 recommendations, together with drafts of legislation
16 necessary to carry its recommendations into effect,
17 by filing the same with the clerk of the house of
18 representatives not later than the first Wednesday of
19 December of the current year.
