The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

An Act relative to the Holding of Professional Sports and Games, so called, on the Lord's Day in the Town of Whitman.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 So much of the provisions of section twenty-two
2 of chapter one hundred and thirty-six of the Gen-
3 eral Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary edi-
4 tion, as provides that "no sport or game shall be
5 permitted in a place other than a public playground
6 or park within one thousand feet of any regular place
7 of worship" shall not apply in the town of Whitman.
