8 thereof. Said division shall report to the general
9 court the results of its investigation, including esti-
10 mates of cost and also its recommendations, if any,
11 together with drafts of legislation necessary for
12 carrying its recommendations into effect, by filing
13 the same with the clerk of the house of representa-
14 tives on or before December first in the current year.
